Suspect sought in early morning shooting

A Shreveport man is recovering after being shot multiple times Monday morning in west Shreveport.

Shortly after 5:00 a.m. on November 14, 2016, Shreveport Police patrol officers were called to the 4200 block of Ester Street relative to a shooting. As officers arrived at the location, it was learned the victim, 42 year old Marquallius Turner, was suffering multiple gunshot wounds to the lower extremities. Turner was transported from the scene via ambulance to University Health hospital, where he is expected to survive.

Preliminary information gathered on the scene of the crime suggests that Turner was outside the Ester Street residence, when numerous gunshots were heard. It was at that time, Turner was located outside the home suffering injuries. Authorities have information suggesting that there were at least two suspects involved in the shooting, who were seen dressed in dark clothing and wearing masks. Investigators with the Shreveport Police Departments Violent Crimes Unit are working at this hour to gather additional information into the crime and are asking persons with any information about the matter to contact Crimestoppers at (318) 673-7373 or visit their website at www.lockemup.org
