Shreveport man jailed in connection with October slaying

Shreveport Police detectives have now arrested and charged a man in connection with a shooting that left one man dead, and two others injured in early September.

Back on October 3, 2016, Shreveport Police patrol officers responded to the 1200 block of Travis Street relative to reports a man had been shot there. As officers arrived at the scene, it was soon learned the victim, 17 year old Bobby Evans was deceased, suffering what appeared to be an apparent gunshot wound. A second shooting victim was identified as 25 year old Damaria Williams of Shreveport, who was found suffering a gunshot wound to the hand, and a third victim, 41 year old Kevin Carr, who was contacted at a local hospital, suffering a gunshot wound to the abdomen. Williams and Carr would survive their injuries.

Preliminary details of the initial shooting were limited; however, authorities continued to work diligently, following up on leads and bits of information which came during the inquiry. This information led officers to identify the suspect in the shooting as 27 year old Tobias Williams of the 1700 block of Alston Street in Shreveport. Investigators along with patrol officers arrived at Williams' Alston Street home where he was taken into police custody without incident. Williams was transported to Shreveport Police headquarters where he met with investigators. Following subsequent interviews with detectives. Williams was booked into the Shreveport City Jail on one count of Second degree murder and two counts of Attempted second degree murder.
