



Discipline Policy

All Children enrolled in SPAR—Summer Therapeutic Recreation Adaptive Camp are to follow SPAR disciplinary plan. Inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated and a parent conference will be scheduled. Any camper that injures another camper will be suspended from the program. If the behavior continues the camper will be terminated from the program.

These actions are considered inappropriate:

- Any type of fighting
- Intimidating, harassing, or threatening others
- The use of profane language, gestures, or behaviors.
- Damaging and/or destroying belonging to SPAR and/or others
- Leaving center grounds without permission.

- Third Offense—Suspension from the program
- Fourth Offense –Termination from the program


