Mayors for CNG Unite

Shreveport Mayor Cedric B. Glover hit the road with Chesapeake representatives this month in a bi-fuel Chevy Tahoe powered in part by compressed natural gas (CNG). To show his support of the Haynesville Shale and the use of Compressed Natural Gas, Mayor Glover tested the bi-fuel vehicle as he traveled to the U.S. Conference of Mayors in Oklahoma City.

At the conference, Glover united with Bossier City Mayor Lo Walker and other U.S. mayors to co-sponsor a resolution encouraging greater use of vehicles that would run on domestically produced, cleaner and less expensive natural gas fuel instead of diesel or gasoline.

"I believe that natural gas vehicles represent a major part of our country's future when it comes to clean, affordable and accessible fuels for both fleet and personal travel. It is a pleasure to partner with Chesapeake to demonstrate this abundant natural resource and the opportunities it could bring to Shreveport and Northwest Louisiana," said Glover.
