HWY. 526) and the northerly right of way line of East Kings Highway, thence north 56 degrees 04'30" west a distance of 695.50 feet along said northerly right of way; thence along the arc of a curve to the left (Radius = 989.63', chord bearing = N62 degrees 05'11"W – 207.28') a distance of 207.66 feet along said northerly right of way; thence north 68 degrees 05'52" west a distance of 34.80 feet along said northerly right of way to the point of beginning; thence continue north 68 degrees 05'52" west a distance of 299.37 feet along said northerly right of way line; Thence North 21 degrees 54'27" east a distance of 467.02 feet to the apparent mean low water line of Old Sand Beach Bayou Lateral C-6; thence approximately along said apparent mean low water line the following four courses: North 55 degrees 24'06" east a distance of 162.65 feet; North 52 degrees 32'12" East a distance of 283.85 feet; North 87 degrees 10'48" east a distance of 22.74 feet; South 44 degrees 13'54" east a distance of 48.46 feet; thence south 21 degrees 54'10" west a distance of 836.71 feet, leaving said apparent mean low water line to

the point of beginning. Said tract herein described containing 4.773 acres, more or less. Section 37, T17N, R13W, Caddo Parish, Louisiana.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that if any provision or item of this ordinance or the application thereof is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions, items, or applications of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provisions, items, or applications and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared severable.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all ordinances or parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
