Warrant for Brandon Wright has been recalled by District Attorney

The warrant for Brandon Wright, accusing him of Attempted Second Degree Murder, has been recalled by the district attorney's office. Please contact the DA's office for more information.

Shreveport Police detectives are seeking the whereabouts of a man wanted in connection to a September stabbing which seriously injured a local woman.

Brandon M. Wright, 35, of the 120 block of Lars Road in Haughton, is sought by police for his alleged role in stabbing Sharonica Campbell several times back on September 7, 2017 at a residence located in the 1900 block of Anna Street. According to information gained during the preliminary phase of the investigation, it was learned Wright arrived at Campbell's home and following a heated argument began stabbing her repeatedly.

Wright fled the scene of the crime, while Campbell was treated at University Health medical Center for her injuries in which she continues to recover. Since the investigation began, detectives with the Shreveport Police Department's Violent Crimes Unit have worked tirelessly in efforts to locate Wright, who is now wanted on an outstanding arrest warrant charging him with a single count of attempted second degree murder. Bond in the matter has been set at half a million dollars.
