Man Injured in north Shreveport shooting

Shreveport Police are investigating a shooting that left a man with serious injuries in north Shreveport late last night.

On January 17, 2018 just after 8:00 pm, Shreveport Police responded to reports of a shooting in the 1500 block of Kenneth Street. They arrived to find 61-year-old Kenneth Jackson suffering from a single gunshot wound that struck both his arm and chest. Jackson was transported to University Health Hospital with serious but non-life threatening injuries.

Detectives and crime scene investigators were summoned to the scene. Detectives interviewed witnesses that reported hearing a gunshot and then Jackson's cries for help. Crime Scene Investigators processed the crime scene and collected evidence. There is no suspect information at this time. This investigation is ongoing.
