Police investigate shooting

Shreveport Police are investigating a shooting that left a man injured last night.

Just before 9:00 pm on April 25, 2018, Shreveport Police patrol officers responded to University Health Hospital on reports of a shooting. Officers contacted 34-year-old Paul Robinson in the emergency room and learned he sustained a gunshot injury to his right knee while walking in a west Shreveport neighborhood. The injury was described as non-life threatening.

Investigators with the Violent Crimes Unit responded to the hospital and interviewed Robinson. Robinson told investigators that he was walking at the intersection of Corbitt Street and Mansfield Road when two or three different people began shooting at each other. He advised that he continued to walk and was unable to see who was shooting. Robinson realized he was shot and was transported to the hospital by private automobile. Investigators and patrol officers scoured the area where the shooting reportedly occurred but were unable to locate a crime scene. The investigation continues.
