Crime Stoppers tip helps police disband gang of vehicle burglars


Investigators with the Shreveport Police Department's Property Crimes Unit have made multiple arrests in a string of vehicle burglaries dating back to late March.

From March 28 through May 1, 2018 Investigators worked a string of burglaries where unlocked vehicles were targeted in southeast Shreveport. During the burglary spree many items of value were taken to include weapons. Video footage of the burglaries was made available to the public and a Shreveport Caddo Crime Stoppers tip soon followed identifying at least one of the individuals. Through a month long investigation detectives uncovered evidence that led to the arrest of 18-year-old Roshun Holden of the 8900 block of Youree Drive for 10 counts of Simple Burglary, 17-year-old Mathew Pollock of the 200 block of Settlers Park Drive for 15 counts of Simple Burglary, 17-year-old Kara Grim of the 10300 block of Loma Vista Drive for 4 counts of Simple Burglary, 17-year-old Andrew Hughes of the 9800 block of Charleston Drive, a 16-year-old juvenile male for 3 counts of Simple Burglary, and another 16-year-old juvenile male for 14 counts of Simple Burglary. All of the adults were booked into the city jail on their charges and the juveniles were booked into the Caddo Parish Juvenile Detention Center. More charges are expected.

This group of accused thieves were linked to burglaries in the Village Green, Apple Tree, and Peppertree neighborhoods that run off of Stratmore Drive in southeast Shreveport as well as Autumn Woods Apartments in the 9000 block of Youree Drive, Stone Canyon Apartments in the 8900 block of Youree Drive, Raintree Apartments in the 8500 block of Millicent Way, Cornerstone Apartments in the 100 block of Southfield Road, the Broadmoor neighborhood along Pennsylvania Avenue and the Shreve Island neighborhood along River Road. During the execution of search warrants investigators recovered large amounts of stolen property that has been returned to the owners; however, there are many recovered items that have gone unclaimed. Investigators are releasing photos of this property in hopes of identifying the owner and getting the property returned. We are asking that everyone browse through the photos and if they recognize an item that belongs to them, contact the Property Crimes Investigations Unit at 318-673-6955.
