Warrant obtained of man accused in domestic situation



Suspect Lee Arthur Taylor Jr.

Shreveport Police investigators are seeking the whereabouts of a man accused of committing a series of domestic related crimes in May.

Lee Arthur Taylor Jr., 40, is now being sought in connection with an ongoing investigation into reports he battered his ex-girlfriend and fired shots at her while small children were present.

Back on May 17, 2018, Shreveport Police patrol officers were called to the 100 block of East College relative to shots fired. As officers arrived at the scene it was learned an adult female and several children were present. The woman, who suffered minor injury reported her ex-boyfriend Lee Arthur Taylor Jr had committed a battery on her and fired a shot at her with a handgun before fleeing the residence on foot. Since the investigation began, evidence was gathered linking Taylor to the crime. Investigators have procured a warrant for the arrest of Taylor, charging him with Illegal use of a weapon, domestic abuse battery with child endangerment and domestic aggravated assault.
