Police arrest man and woman following shots fired incident

Shreveport Police have filed additional charges against a man accused of firing shots outside of a west Shreveport home this weekend.

On October 6, 2018, Shreveport Police patrol officers responded to reports of shots being fired outside of a home in the 3000 block of Syphon Street. Concerned citizens reported that a man was standing in the front yard of the residence firing shots from a handgun. Arriving officers detained the man believed responsible, 32-year-old Calvin Underwood of the 3000 block of Syphon Street. Officers searched the home and located Marijuana and an extended magazine hidden in the oven in the kitchen area of the residence. Officers believed that the weapon used in the incident was concealed within a vehicle parked in front of the residence but were not able to access the vehicle at that time. During their on scene investigation officers learned that 32-year-old Winters Underwood also of the 3000 block of Syphon Street, allegedly hid the keys to the vehicle to prevent officers from searching the car and recovering the weapon used in the crime.

Patrol officers contacted investigators with the Violent Crimes Bureau and detectives seized the vehicle and procured a search warrant. Patrol officers charged Calvin Underwood with Illegal Use of a weapon and Possession of Schedule 1 and booked him into the Shreveport City Jail. They also charged Winters Underwood with one count of Obstruction of Justice.

On October 9, 2018, Investigators executed the search warrant and located the handgun believed used in the crime inside of the vehicle and added and charged Calvin Underwood with one count of Felon in Possession of a Firearm. Underwood has been arrested multiple times by Shreveport Police for Domestic Abuse Battery, property crimes offenses, and drug related offenses. He is currently housed at Caddo Correctional Center.
