Police investigate deadly overnight domestic incident

Investigators with Shreveport Police Department's Violent Crimes Unit are investigating an early morning domestic incident that left a man dead.

On June 6, 2020, just after 1:20 a.m., Shreveport Police patrol officers were dispatched to a shooting in the 3200 block of Boss Avenue. On arrival, officers located a man inside of the home with what appeared to be a single gunshot injury to the upper body. The man succumbed to his injuries on scene. The Caddo Parish Coroner's Office took custody of the decedent.

Violent Crimes and Crime Scene Investigators responded to the scene. Witnesses were interviewed and evidence collected. Detectives learned that the man who was shot was the estranged boyfriend of the homeowner. They believe the man entered the residence forcibly and once inside, attacked the homeowner and made threats to kill her. She armed herself with a handgun and shot the male once in what investigators believe was an act of self-defense. The investigation is ongoing, and no other details will be released at this time.
