Investigators make final arrest in March murder attempt

Investigators have jailed another man in connection with the early March homicide attempt on a Shreveport couple

On March 5, 2020, just before 8:00 p.m., Shreveport Police were called to Willis Knighton South hospital on reports of a man that arrived at their emergency room by personal vehicle suffering multiple non-life threatening gunshot injuries. Arriving officers contacted the male victim and learned that a vehicle had pulled alongside of him at the intersection of Meriwether Road and Jewella Avenue and fired multiple shots into their vehicle. A woman and small child were also in the vehicle when the shooting occurred, but were not injured. The victim was transported to Ochsners LSU Health and continues to recover.

Investigators with the Crime Scene and Violent Crimes Units were summoned to the scene and launched their investigation. Through investigative interviews and evidence collected from the scene detectives were able to identify Multiple suspects in the ordeal.

On March 9, 2020, 21-year-old Johnthrell Crutchfield was taken into custody and following interviews was booked into the Shreveport City Jail on one count of Attempted First Degree Murder.

On March 28, 2020, investigators procured warrants charging 18-year-old Quinterrius Brown, of the 900 block of N Lakewood Drive, and 20-year-old Calveon Raphiel, of the 100 block Gavin Lane, with one count of Attempted First Degree Murder relative to the shooting. Bond was set at \$100,000.00 each.

On April 22, 2020, investigators charged 18-year-old Kadarius Jenkins, of the 2700 block Regent St, with one count of Principle to First Degree Murder relative to the shooting. That same day detectives were able to locate Quinterrius Brown. They were able to take him into custody without incident. Following interviews with investigators, he was booked into the Shreveport City Jail on his warrant.

On June 30, 2020, just before 7:30 p.m., Shreveport Police were called to Ochsners LSU Health on reports of a male arriving by private vehicle suffering from a gunshot injury. He was suffering from life-threatening injuries. Officers were able to speak with, 21-year-old Calveon Raphiel, prior to him being taken into surgery. Raphiel told officers he was walking down Carleton Avenue when he was shot by an unknown individual in a white Crown Vic. No crime scene was located. Raphiel remains hospitalized and will be booked into the Shreveport City Jail on his warrant when released.
