Saturday night dispute ends with stabbing

A late Saturday night dispute has left one Shreveport man hospitalized and another in custody.

On Saturday November 7, 2020 just after 8:30 p.m., Shreveport Police responded to the 1600 block of David Raines at Forrest Oak Apartments relative to a stabbing. Officers located 44 year old Lorenzo Washington in a nearby apartment suffering from multiple stab wounds to the body. The victim was transported to Ochsner LSU Health with possible life-threatening injuries. According to witnesses, Washington engaged in a verbal dispute with Nakemin Sanders (11-06-1992) which resulted in Sanders stabbing Washington with a knife. Sanders, was detained when officers arrived. He is also accused of punching his mother in the face during the dispute. She sustained a minor laceration to her eye.

Violent Crimes investigators were summoned to the location and collected evidence. Following witness interviews, and an interview with Sanders, he was charged with one count of Aggravated Second Degree Battery and one count of Domestic Abuse Battery. He was booked into the Shreveport City Jail.
