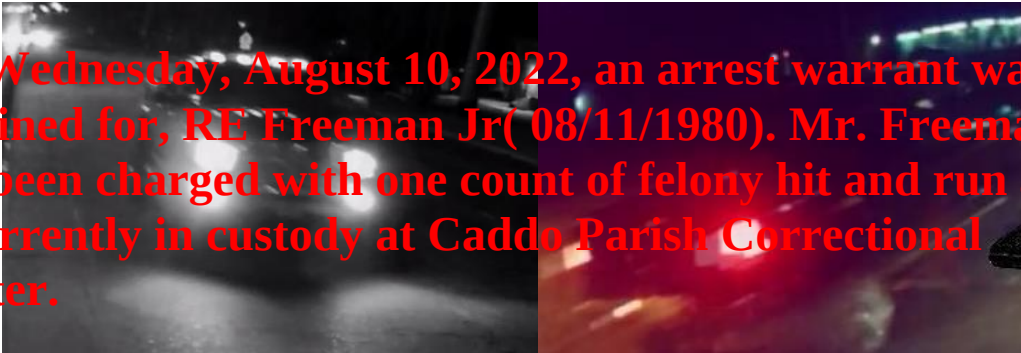

UPDATE: Suspect sought in hit and run kills man



On Wednesday, August 10, 2022, an arrest warrant was obtained for, RE Freeman Jr(08/11/1980). Mr. Freeman has been charged with one count of felony hit and run and is currently in custody at Caddo Parish Correctional Center.

On Friday, July 15, 2022, at 9:30p.m., the Shreveport Police Department responded to a report of a pedestrian that was struck by a vehicle. Arriving officers located a white male victim suffering from serious injuries in the roadway. The victim was transported to a local area hospital where he subsequently died.

Witnesses to the crash stated that the victim was crossing Linwood Avenue in front of a Sportran bus when struck by the passing vehicle. The suspect vehicle then fled the scene.

Police are releasing a photograph of the suspect vehicle and asking for the assistance of the community in identifying the accused.
