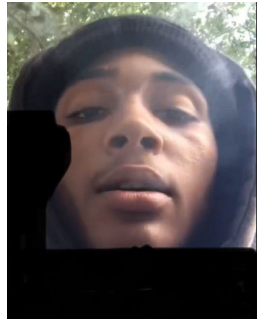

Police search for man charged with Attempted Murder

Investigators have named the man believe responsible for the shooting of a 15-year-old outside of a residence in the 2700 block of Marquette Street Tuesday evening.

On August 01, 2023, Shreveport Police patrol officers responded to reports of a shooting on the 2700 block of Marquette Street. Arriving officers located a male teenager who was suffering from multiple gunshot injuries at a residence in the block. He was transported to Ochsner LSU Health Hospital with life-threatening injuries. He is expected to recover.

Investigators with the Violent Crimes and Crime Scene Unit responded to the scene. CSIU collected evidence while investigators searched for video and interviewed witnesses. Evidence collected throughout the week led them to identify 18-year-old Omareon Spann (2-5-2005) as the person they believe responsible. On August 4th investigators procured warrants for Spann charging him with (1) one count of Attempted Second-Degree Murder and (1) count of Aggravated Criminal Property Damage. No bond has been set.

Investigators are encouraging Spann to surrender himself to authorities. They are also asking anyone with information as to his whereabouts to contact the Shreveport Police Department immediately at 318-673-7300 #3. Spann is considered to be armed and dangerous.

All suspects are innocent until proven guilty.
