CITY TO PAUSE BIDS ON NORTH MARKET POLICE SUBSTATION

Mayor Tom Arceneaux announced today that the City of Shreveport will pause the bidding process for the construction of a police substation on North Market Street.

“I have asked our staff to pause the bidding process to give us time to work through and resolve some concerns expressed by the City Council about the terms of the donation of the land on which the substation would be located. Rather than potentially penalizing bidders by asking them to submit a bid before the issues were resolved, I think it is better to pause the process now.”

The North Market substation is funded by a bond issue approved by the voters in late 2021. Once constructed, it will house Police patrol officers assigned to North Shreveport.
