**Shreveport Police Arrest Jeffrey Reed Following Disturbing Incident**

The Shreveport Police Department has arrested Jeffrey Reed following a disturbing incident that occurred on February 6, 2025, around 2:00 AM. Reed reportedly picked up two juveniles, ages 13 and 14, and transported them to a motel located in the 3900 block of Greenwood Road.

The juveniles had left their residence to visit a friend's house at approximately 11:00 PM on February 5. While returning home, Reed offered them a ride but instead took them to a motel. At the motel, Reed allegedly refused to allow the juveniles to leave, displayed pornographic images, and attempted to sexually assault them.

Reed has been charged with the following offenses:

- Two counts of Simple Kidnapping
- Two counts of Indecent Behavior with a Juvenile
- One count of False Imprisonment

Officers apprehended Reed after deploying a Taser due to his resistance. He was transported to a local area hospital, where he was treated for injuries sustained during the arrest.

This case highlights the outstanding work of the Shreveport Police Juvenile Crimes Detectives and our dedicated patrol officers. We encourage all parents and guardians to remain vigilant and informed about their children's activities. Remember, your child's safety is your responsibility.
