SPD Continues to Crack Down on Illegal Firearm Possession



The Shreveport Police Department continues to prioritize removing firearms from the hands of individuals who are prohibited from possessing them. We want to commend our officers for their outstanding work. These dedicated men and women work tirelessly every day to make our community safer, and we will continue to highlight their tremendous efforts.

Here are just a few examples of our recent hard work:

March 23, 2025 — 9:00 PM:

Officers were dispatched to the 4700 block of Lyba Street in reference to an armed person. Responding officers made contact with 26-year-old **Najee Agee**, who was found to be in possession of a concealed handgun. The investigation revealed that Agee was prohibited from possessing a firearm due to a 2017 armed robbery conviction. The handgun was also discovered to be stolen. Agee now faces charges of possession of a firearm by a convicted felon, illegal possession of a stolen firearm, and aggravated assault with a firearm related to the initial call for service.

March 23, 2025 — 6:00 PM:

Earlier that evening, officers conducted a traffic stop and arrested 31-year-old **Gabriel Crockett**. Initially stopped for not having a driver's license, further investigation revealed he was in possession of a firearm. Crockett was also found to be a convicted felon with prior narcotics offenses. He now faces charges of possession of a firearm by a convicted felon, along with multiple traffic violations.

March 24, 2025 — 4:00 AM:

In the early morning hours, officers stopped 33-year-old **Richard Graham** during a traffic stop. He was found to be in possession of multiple types of narcotics and a stolen firearm. Further investigation revealed that Graham had prior felony convictions for narcotics offenses, making him prohibited from possessing a firearm. He now faces multiple narcotics distribution charges and possession of a firearm by a convicted felon.

March 21, 2025 — 7:00 PM:

While proactively patrolling, officers conducted a traffic stop for a seatbelt violation and made contact with 29-year-old

Nathan Wilson. The stop quickly escalated when officers discovered he was in possession of a firearm. Wilson was prohibited from possessing a firearm due to a 2022 conviction for illegal use of a weapon during a shooting. He has been arrested for possession of a firearm by a convicted felon.

All firearms from these incidents have been seized as evidence. The Shreveport Police Department is proud to report that we are approaching nearly 300 guns seized in 2025 alone. We will continue to highlight the efforts of our officers as they work daily to protect the citizens of Shreveport.
