Shreveport Police Respond to Domestic Violence Stabbing

Just after 10:00 a.m. on April 1, 2025, officers with the Shreveport Police Department responded to a reported stabbing at 2719 Regent Street. Upon arrival, officers discovered that a male victim had been stabbed in the shoulder during a domestic dispute.

The victim was transported to a local hospital with non-life-threatening injuries. SPD's Domestic Violence Unit was notified and initiated an investigation.

The suspect, identified as Tatyana Thomas, was taken into custody at the scene. She has been charged with:

- One count of Domestic Abuse Battery with Serious Bodily Injury
- One count of Domestic Abuse Battery with Child Endangerment
