Two Arrested in Separate Incidents by Shreveport Police

On April 23, 2025, Shreveport Police officers responded to two unrelated but serious incidents, resulting in the arrests of two individuals.

At approximately 4:12 p.m., officers executed an arrest warrant in the 500 block of Browning Street. Clyde Bradford was taken into custody on 15 outstanding traffic warrants. During the arrest, officers discovered that Bradford—who is a convicted felon—was in possession of a firearm. He now faces an additional charge of felony possession of a firearm, along with his outstanding warrants.

Earlier that day, officers responded to a disturbance call in the 3300 block of Chaumont Circle. Upon arrival, officers found that a family dispute had escalated, with Takiyah Hayes allegedly threatening family members with a knife. Hayes was determined to be intoxicated at the time of the incident. She was taken into custody, transported to a local hospital for evaluation, and ultimately booked into the Shreveport City Jail for one count of aggravated assault.
