Traffic Stop Leads to Arrest of Armed Felon in MLK Area

In the early morning hours of April 25, 2025, around 2:00 a.m., officers with the Shreveport Police Department conducting directed patrols in the Martin Luther King Jr. area initiated a traffic stop in the 2900 block of Martin Luther King Jr. Drive.

The driver of the vehicle was identified as Trevon Harrison. Initially, Harrison provided officers with a false name; however, further investigation revealed his correct identity and that he had outstanding warrants for his arrest.

Upon further inspection, officers discovered that Harrison was in possession of narcotics and a loaded assault rifle. Investigators later confirmed that Harrison is a convicted felon, legally prohibited from possessing firearms. Additional narcotics were also recovered during the stop.

Harrison was taken into custody and now faces multiple charges, including his outstanding warrant, possession of a firearm by a convicted felon, possession of a controlled dangerous substance, and providing false information to law enforcement.

The Shreveport Police Department remains committed to proactively patrolling our neighborhoods and removing dangerous individuals and illegal weapons from our streets.
