Shreveport Fire Hosts “Hearts on Fire” Campaign

Shreveport, LA: The Shreveport Fire Department will be celebrating the the start of the 2025 Camp I’m Still Me on May 31, 2025. Please join us at our open house locations as we invite the public to tour fire stations, meet firefighters, learn fire safety, and promote this invaluable summer camp.

Camp I’m Still Me (CISM) is a free summer camp for children ages 5-17 who have sustained burn injuries. It was founded in 1992 by burn specialist Dr. Kevin Sittig and is held annually in Scottsdale, Texas. Campers participate in various activities such as games, crafts, swimming, and fishing, and find comfort and support in the 3:1 camper-to-counselor ration, along with adult burn survivors as counselors. The camp also offers emotional healing and the formation of lasting bonds with other burn survivors. It is staffed yearly by healthcare professionals and firefighters within our community whose mission is to bring joy and healing to these young survivors.
