## Arson and Assault Suspect Taken into Custody

On July 9th, Shreveport Police officers responded to an apartment complex on Millicent Way following reports that Jaylon Davis had made threats toward a victim. The victim provided credible information regarding the threats, prompting further investigation.

While on scene, officers observed evidence of what appeared to be an arson attempt outside the victim's apartment. This was later confirmed through text messages allegedly sent by Davis, which supported the victim's claims.

Over the following days, the victim filed additional reports in which Davis remained a suspect in ongoing harassment. Investigators with the Shreveport Fire Department also launched a parallel investigation into the suspected arson.

On July 22nd, officers again responded to a call from the victim and located Davis, who was taken into custody. He was charged with simple assault and also arrested on an outstanding warrant for aggravated arson stemming from the July 9th investigation.

We thank the dedicated officers of the Shreveport Police Department and our partners at the Shreveport Fire Department for their outstanding work and collaboration on this case.
