**Your Tax Dollars at Work: Parking Lot Improvements Underway at Cross Lake and Southern Hills**

The City of Shreveport's Parks and Recreation Department (SPAR) is excited to announce two much-anticipated parking lot improvement projects that will soon be underway. These upgrades reflect the City's commitment to listening to residents and reinvesting tax dollars into the facilities and spaces our community enjoys every day.

**Cross Lake Boat Launch Improvements**

The Cross Lake Boat Launch parking lot will be closed beginning September 22nd through September 29th while resurfacing and improvements are completed. During this time, boaters are encouraged to use alternative launch sites around the lake, including:

- **Melvin's Landing**
- **Barron's Landing & Marina**
- **Ark-La-Tex Landing**
- **Johnson's Fishing Camp**
- **Shreveport Yacht Club**
- **Municipal Pier & Boat Launch** (*only free option, others have a small fee*)

"We know how much our community loves Cross Lake, and these improvements will provide a safer, smoother, and more welcoming parking area for years to come," said Shelly Ragle, Director of SPAR.

**Southern Hills Recreation Center – Lower Parking Lot**

In addition, work will begin this week on the lower parking lot at Southern Hills Recreation Center near the tennis courts. Crews will begin preparation immediately, with final resurfacing and improvements scheduled for the first week of October.

This project is another direct response to community feedback. *You asked for it... we listened.* Once complete, the new lot will make the Southern Hills Recreation Center more accessible for families, tennis players, and community members who use the facility daily.
