ROADWAY REPAIRS BEGIN ON STRATMORE DRIVE OCTOBER 10th, 2025

The City of Shreveport's Department of Engineering announces that roadway construction along Stratmore Drive from Pugh Avenue to Stratmore Circle will begin on Friday, October 10, 2025.

Contractors will be removing and replacing deficient concrete roadway panels over the next several months. The work will be completed in two phases to maintain traffic flow throughout the project.


- Phase One will involve repairs to the outermost eastbound and westbound lanes, with thru traffic maintained in the inner lanes.
- Phase Two will repair the innermost eastbound and westbound lanes, with thru traffic maintained in the outermost lanes.

No full lane closures are expected, and thru traffic will be permitted for the duration of the project.


