**CROSS LAKE BRIDGE NIGHTTIME LANE CLOSURES WILL BEGIN NOVEMBER 6, 2025,  
TO CONTINUE NEXT PHASE OF LIGHTING PROJECT**

Thursday evening on November 6<sup>th</sup>, The City of Shreveport will begin nighttime lane closures on the Cross Lake Bridge, weather permitting, to continue the next phase of the lighting project that began in June 2023. The nightly lane closures will begin at 6:00 pm and will be removed by 6:00 am each morning.

The closures will start with the inside lane of the bridge in the westbound direction, and once completed, the inside lane of the bridge in the eastbound direction will be closed. The lane closures are necessary to allow the contractor to safely replace the wiring and luminaires along the bridge.

PLEASE USE CAUTION! Always drive safely and take precautions when driving through any construction site. The lane closures will cause the clear width of the bridge to be less than eighteen (18) feet during the nightly lane closures. Motorists are advised to plan travel accordingly.
