Montrose Drive Temporary Closure

The City of Shreveport advises motorists that beginning **Monday, December 15, 2025**, construction activities will commence along **Montrose Drive** from Fairfield Avenue to Thornhill Drive.

This closure is required to facilitate roadway reconstruction, drainage, and ADA pedestrian improvements. Construction will be done in sequential phases:

Phase I (Beginning December 15, 2025)

- A portion of the 800 Block of Montrose Drive will be closed to through traffic.
- During this phase there will **not** be direct access to Montrose Drive from Thornhill Drive (both segments)
- The Contractor is working closely with the City of Shreveport as well as Fairfield Elementary Magnet School to coordinate efforts to minimize impacts on school as well as maintain access for buses and car pick up lines.

Motorists are urged to **use caution when traveling through the work zone**, to **obey all posted signs and detour routes**, and to be mindful of workers and equipment in the area.

The City of Shreveport appreciates the public's patience and cooperation as we continue to improve our roadway infrastructure.
