Armed Convicted Felon Arrested in Domestic Incident

Just after 1:00 p.m. on January 6, Shreveport Police officers responded to a domestic disturbance in the 3200 block of Milton Street. While gathering information, dispatchers reported a chaotic scene inside the residence, including a female screaming and a juvenile stating that a male had struck him.

Officers arrived swiftly and took Trey Catts into custody without further incident. During contact, Catts was found to be armed with a firearm. Subsequent investigation revealed that he was prohibited from possessing a firearm due to prior felony convictions, including illegal use of a weapon in 2021 and felon in possession of a firearm in 2022.

Catts now faces one additional count of felon in possession of a firearm and two counts of cruelty to a juvenile in connection with this domestic incident.

The Shreveport Police Department commends the responding officers for their quick actions and their efforts to de-escalate the situation before any serious injuries could occur. Domestic violence and the illegal possession of firearms will not be tolerated in our community.
