Crime Stoppers Tip Leads to Warrants in Bank Fraud & Identity Theft Case



The Shreveport Police Department announces that a Crime Stoppers tip has led to the identification of two suspects and the issuance of arrest warrants in a bank fraud and identity theft investigation involving a total loss of \$7,179.43 to Community Bank.

As a result of the investigation, Jonathan Ogburn and Christina W. Cox are now wanted on charges related to bank fraud.

According to investigators, Community Bank reported that Jonathan Ogburn opened an account on December 5, 2025. Between December 21 and December 26, 2025, surveillance footage showed a white female depositing 11 fraudulent checks into Ogburn's account. The checks were made payable to Jonathan Ogburn and styled in the names of two other individuals.

Following the deposits, large ATM withdrawals and purchases were conducted from the account, resulting in the financial loss to the bank.

Through investigative efforts and information provided to Crime Stoppers, detectives identified Christina W. Cox as the individual captured on surveillance footage depositing the fraudulent checks.

Investigators also confirmed that Christina W. Cox is currently on probation for bank fraud and has a documented history of issuing worthless checks and identity theft.

Warrants have now been issued for Jonathan Ogburn and Christina W. Cox, and both remain wanted at this time.

The Shreveport Police Department reminds the public that Crime Stoppers tips play a vital role in solving crimes and holding offenders accountable.
