Two Officers Recovering After Possible Fentanyl Exposure

This morning, two Shreveport Police officers were transported for medical evaluation following a possible fentanyl exposure while serving an arrest warrant in the 2000 block of **Grimmett Drive** at a local apartment complex.

During the operation, one officer immediately began showing signs consistent with possible fentanyl exposure and was administered Narcan by a fellow officer on scene. A short time later, a second officer also began exhibiting symptoms. Out of an abundance of caution, both officers were transported to a local medical facility for observation.

Both officers are currently doing well and remain in good spirits.

The Shreveport Fire Department responded quickly and assisted on scene. The Shreveport Police Department extends its sincere appreciation to our fire partners for their rapid response and continued support.

Shreveport Police Narcotics and HazMat units responded and are continuing to work to ensure the area is safe. The investigation remains ongoing, and additional information will be released as it becomes available.
