Facebook Marketplace Deal Looking A Little Too Good To Be True? There May Be A Reason.

On March 17, 2026, Shreveport Police detectives were contacted in reference to a stolen vehicle investigation and recovery. Detectives learned that DriveTime was in the process of reporting a vehicle stolen from its property when that vehicle was ultimately tracked to a residence in Caddo Parish.

While assisting the Caddo Parish Sheriff's Office with the recovery, investigators discovered that the female in possession of the vehicle believed she had legally purchased it from a seller on Facebook Marketplace.

As the investigation continued, detectives determined this was actually the **second vehicle stolen from DriveTime and sold through Facebook Marketplace by the same seller.**

Investigators learned that both buyers had been provided what appeared to be legitimate paperwork, including a Bill of Sale and Texas title documents. Those documents were later determined to be fictitious.

Through the investigation, and with the help of the buyers' own social media interactions with the suspect, detectives were able to identify the seller as: **Christian Devante Efferson (B/M, DOB: 01/21/2006)**

A warrant has now been issued for Efferson on:

- **2 counts of Illegal Possession of Stolen Things**
