## Woman Arrested After Allegedly Stealing Vehicle, Cash, and Attempting to Ram Victim



**Elisa Maria Palma**

On March 24, 2026, at approximately 4:29 p.m., Shreveport Police officers were dispatched to a suspicious vehicle call at 110 East Bert Kouns Industrial Loop (Home Depot).

Upon arrival, officers made contact with Caddo Sheriff's Office deputies who had detained a white female later identified as **Elisa Maria Palma (12/12/1989)**.

Deputies were initially contacted by a complainant who reported that Palma had stolen his 2004 Toyota 4Runner. The complainant advised officers that earlier in the day, Palma allegedly took cash, his driver's license, credit and debit cards, and his iPhone 11, along with his vehicle.

The complainant later observed Palma in the Home Depot parking lot. When Palma attempted to leave the area toward a nearby bank, the complainant alerted deputies, who made contact with Palma inside the stolen vehicle and detained her.

During the investigation, officers located inside Palma's the complainant's driver's license and multiple credit/debit cards. The complainant's iPhone 11 was also recovered from inside the vehicle.

A witness further reported that Palma attempted to ram his vehicle, causing him to jump a curb to avoid being struck. Home Depot personnel advised that surveillance video captured the incident.

After being advised of her rights, Palma stated the cash found in her possession belonged to her.

Investigators learned that Palma and the complainant reside in the same household and are former dating partners. Due to conflicting claims regarding ownership, the recovered cash was logged into evidence for safekeeping.

Based on the investigation, **Elisa Maria Palma** was arrested and transported to the **Shreveport City Jail**, where she was charged with:

- **Unauthorized Use of a Motor Vehicle (Vehicle Theft)**
- **Theft**
- **Aggravated Assault**

This case remains under investigation.
