Due to a valving down of a water main, a voluntary boil water advisory is being issued to your area. Please read and adhere to the information below:

Site Location: The Martin Luther King (MLK) Area including Northside Elementary, Green Oaks High, Pine Grove Elementary and Southern University Shreveport

The water supplied by our water distribution system to your facility is of questionable microbiological quality.

Therefore, as a **precaution**, the Shreveport Water System is issuing a **VOLUNTARY BOIL ADVISORY** effective until you are further notified that the advisory has been rescinded by Shreveport's Water System.

It is recommended that water be disinfected before consuming it{ including fountain drinks, making ice, brushing teeth, or using it for food preparation or rinsing of foods } by the following means:

Boil water for one (1) full minute in a clean container. The one minute starts after the water has been brought to a rolling boil; the flat taste can be eliminated by shaking the water in a clean bottle or pouring it from one clean container to another.

Again, please be sure to disinfect your own water prior to consumption until you have been advised otherwise.

When satisfactory laboratory test results are obtained, the Shreveport's Water Supply personnel will then rescind the Boil Advisory and notify you that your water has been deemed safe.
