Suspect nabbed in armed robbery of local convenience store



A local man has been jailed in connection with the armed robbery of a local convenience store in north Shreveport.

Just before 10:00 p.m. on April 11, 2016, Shreveport Police Patrol officers responded to a reported armed robbery at the Circle K in the 1900 block of North Market Street. Upon arrival, authorities learned a suspect allegedly robbed the store with a handgun and took an undisclosed amount of money. The suspect was described as a black male wearing all dark clothing. The suspect reportedly fled the scene on foot in an unknown direction. No employees were not injured during the robbery.

Since the initiation of an investigation conducted by Shreveport Police Robbery detectives, information and evidence has been gathered linking 19 year old Timothy Singleton of the 1700 block of Pointe Coupee Drive to the crime. Detectives were able to locate Singleton at his home, Wednesday afternoon where he was taken into police custody. Following subsequent interviews with authorities at police headquarters, Singleton was charged with a single count of Armed Robbery and booked into the Shreveport City Jail.
