SFD Observes 2016 National Fire Prevention Week National Fire Prevention Week: Sun. Oct. 9th – Sat., Oct.15th Theme: “Don’t wait, Check the date.”

According to the latest National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) research, “cooking is the leading cause of residential and non-residential building fires.” In an effort to prevent fire related injury or death, the Shreveport Fire Department is recommending citizens check their smoke alarms and follow fire safety tips:

- Never leave food unattended!
- Turn off the stove even if you have to leave the kitchen for a short period of time.
- Keep children and pets at least 3 feet away from the stove.
- When you cook, wear clothing with tight-fitting sleeves.
- Immediately, clean food and grease from burners and the stovetop after each use.
